In the picture you can see nine members of the British royal family.

The lady in the white coat with a white hat is Queen Elizabeth.

Her husband, Prince Philip, is on the far right of the photograph.

They have got four children, three sons and a daughter, Princess Anne.

Princess Anne and two of their sons, Prince Andrew and Prince Edward, are not in the photo. There is only their oldest son, Prince Charles.

Prince Charles's second wife, Duchess Camilla, is standing next to him, on the far left of the photograph. She is wearing a green dress.

Between the Queen and Prince Charles is Prince William, the older son of Prince Charles and his first wife, Princess Diana.


He is holding his baby son, Prince George. The prince's mother, Duchess Catherine, is behind the Queen.
