

Animal homes

Like people, animals need shelters to live in. These shelters are their homes. They protect animals from heat, cold, rain and other dangerous things or animals. Different animals live in different kinds of homes. Here are some of them.

People make homes for domestic animals – farm animals and pets.



Coop

Chickens have coops, usually in a garden.



Shed

Cows eat and sleep in sheds. There is usually a lot of dry grass.



Kennel

Dogs' outside shelters are kennels.



Aquarium

Fish live in aquariums. This one is in the dining room.



Stable

Horses stay in stables. They are often made of wood.



Sty

Pigs live in sties. There is usually a lot of mud.

Wild animals make their own shelters.

**Hives**

Bees make hives in the trees.

**Nest**

Birds live in nests made of twigs and branches.

**Den**

Lions and wolves have dens. These are often in caves.

**Hole**

Mice and snakes dig holes in the ground.

**Burrow**

Rabbits stay in burrows, which are bigger than holes.

**Cobweb**

Spiders weave cobwebs, both outside and inside people's houses.
