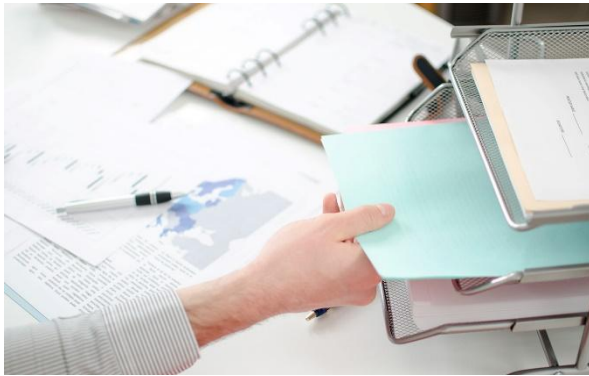


Many skills for one job

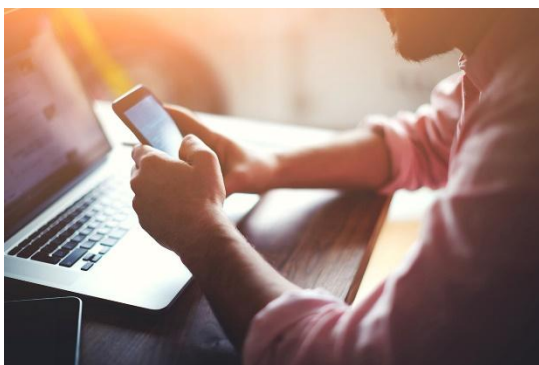
