

Cosplaying is dressing up to look like a fictional character as much as possible. It is not just playing dress-up, or buying costumes. The best cosplayers make their own clothes and props. They are crafty and can often sew, paint, do metalwork or woodwork, and come up with various gadgets to be more convincing. They also like to perform, pretending to be their favourite character.



In **table-top and role-playing games**, you can either use figures of well-known characters, or become one yourself. For a table-top game, you usually need a game board, and you play sitting down. In role-playing, you imagine who you are and act out the game wherever you like. The important thing is to play the entire game as the character you chose – and try to win, of course. This is best when you have other people who share your interest, so you can play in a group.
